



## CAMP KIT LIST

The following is the recommended kit list.

Please remember that all items of kit MUST be marked clearly with the boy's/girls name (coloured marks or shapes are not acceptable – we have more Cubs than colours in the rainbow). Also, no items made of denim should be taken.

All medication should be marked with full dosage directions, placed in a bag with the child's name, and handed to a leader on arrival. No child should carry their own medication for the safety of others.

Those marked with an \* are optional.

Full Uniform

**Waterproof** anorak or cagoule (*tested before camp*)

Old trainers or plimsolls for camp wear (1 pair)

Boots (1 pair Wellington/Hiking)

Shirts/t-shirts

Warm pullover (*2 thin ones are warmer than 1 thick one*)

Shorts

Hat

Trousers (Combats, jogging bottoms, **no jeans**)

Towel(s)

Pyjamas

Tissues

Underwear

Socks

Rucksack, kitbag or holdall (*soft, not a suitcase*)

Sleeping bag

Groundsheet

\* Pillow or pillowcase

Plastic bags for storing wet/dirty clothing

Torch with spare batteries and bulb

Wash bag: Soap in plastic container, face cloth, toothbrush and paste, comb

Sun cream

\* Camp blanket

\* Books/comics for reading or quiet (non-electronic, non-Pokémon) game

\* Pocket Money (up to £5)

\* Teddy

Under no circumstances are Pocket Knives, Sheath Knives, Radios, MP3 players, Mini Televisions, Mobile Phones etc to be brought to camp. Any Cub found with any of these items will be sent home. We accept no excuses.

No tuck please.

All Cubs are expected to wear full uniform whilst journeying to and from the campsite.
