General Notes

1. We would ask that your Son/Daughter travel to and from the Camp/Holiday **in uniform** (Boots are acceptable footwear). Scouts arriving without full uniform (shirt, trousers, scarf, woggle, and belt) will not be taken to camp.
2. **MOBILE PHONES are NOT permitted on camp.**
3. Day bag is for carrying small items on hikes, beach and day trips, packed lunches and drinks.
4. Please place wash proof name labels in all clothing, which should have your Sons/Daughters Name or initials.
5. Games or similar items (i.e. radios, iPod etc) which require batteries to run are not allowed on camp.
6. PL's are to ensure the patrol has at least 1 alarm clock and 1 basic first aid kit.



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Equipment Notes ~ Pocket Money ~ Jewellery

Here is some basic information regarding some of the items you may require / should be aware of.

- Sleeping Bags** Synthetic filled bags are easier to clean than natural filling. Zips can be a source of cold if no baffle is fitted.
- Footwear** Boots give a better ankle support and normally have better soles than shoes if you are hiking.
- Warm Wear** A number of layers is warmer than one thick one and the warmth can be regulated more easily - do not forget your hands and head.
- Jeans** Jeans can be brought to camp but an alternative is also advisable as Jeans take a much longer period to dry compared to other materials.
- Torch** Do not pack your torch with batteries fitted (or at the bottom of your kit) as it could easily get accidentally turned on and you will arrive at the camp/holiday with flat batteries.
- Camera** Cameras are expensive and therefore not recommended.
- Pocket Money** A certain amount of pocket money is recommended. £20 max. for 1 week, £40 max. for 2 weeks
Money must be handed in for safety and will be given out as required. The Scout Group is otherwise not responsible for losses.
- Jewellery** Earrings, nose rings, and other decorative jewellery are **NOT** recommended on camps and activities.
- Valuables** The group can take no responsibility for any items of value brought to camp.
